THE LEVEL 5 HIGHER LEVEL APPRENTICESHIP (HLA) IN ACCOUNTANCY OPENS A WORLD OF OPPORTUNITY IN NORTHERN IRELAND'S ACCOUNTANCY & FINANCE SECTOR

The apprenticeship is a system of employment-focused training and education which enables apprentices to obtain the skills, knowledge and competence required to perform effectively as an Accounting Technician.

It provides apprentices with a paid, practical and fully funded route towards a professional career in accountancy. Graduates work in roles as fully qualified Accounting Technicians in industry, practice and public sector organisations.

- You will be employed in an accountancy practice or an organisation with a suitable accounts department for two years.
- The Level 5 Diploma^{*} programme accredited by CCEA is an industryrecognised qualification.
- You will gain valuable knowledge, practical skills and work experience as well as an internationally recognised accounting qualification.

Entry Requirements: You should have a keen interest in accountancy. In addition, you should:

- Possess a minimum grade B in GCSE Maths and grade C in GCSE English (or universityapproved equivalent;)
- Have obtained a Level 3/A level or equivalent qualification equating to 96 UCAS points;
- Secure employment with an approved employer who will support you through the HLA programme.

Mature students who do not hold the required minimum educational requirements may still apply based on qualifications and experience.










HOW DOES THE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMME WORK?

HIGHER LEVEL APPRENTICESHIP IN ACCOUNTANCY PROFFESSIONAL CAREER PATHWAY



- You will get a minimum of a two-year contract with an employer in industry, practice or the public sector. You work four days a week and study one day a week with a local Further Education college.
- You will be mentored in the workplace and college, putting learning into practice every day, as you go from complete beginner to fully-qualified Accounting Technician.
- You will exit the programme with two years' work experience and a chance to continue your studies in professional accountancy or to degree level.
